During these events our goal has been simple, to live out what Proverbs 11.24 -25 call us to do. To learn to give freely, no strings attached. No advertisement for our church, no hidden agenda, no requirement that they meet our definition of being "in need." We just learn how to give. During these events, I have been learning that this is a hard thing to do. I want to give, but I often want to maintain some sort of control or require some sort of response to the gift I give, but the words of the Proverb writer ring in my ears.

One person gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, but comes to poverty.

A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

When we give freely, we don't get to choose, we don't get to control, we just get the opportunity to bless someone else. To love them without condition and without judgment. My hope is that you have been learning as well that when we give freely, we actually gain something, and when we refuse to give, it is us who loses out. When we are generous we indeed will benefit and as we bring refreshment to others, through a cold treat, a car wash, or a simple act of kindness, we too will be refreshed.
